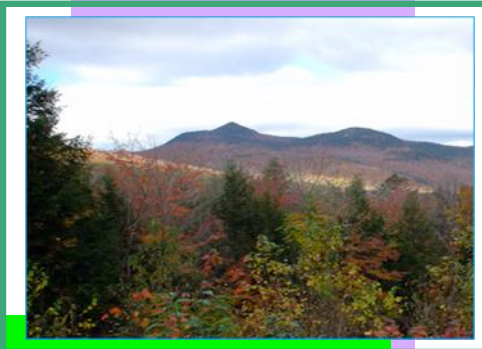


Important Maine land conservation leaders will discuss how conservation happens and how they've adjusted to the current economy. Meet these influential directors who will respond to your questions and comments.

- **Alan Hutchinson, Forest Society of Maine**, executive director, protecting 1 million acres in Maine; and
- **Bryan Wentzell, AMC'**, Maine Policy Director, protecting a 63-mile conservation corridor in the North Maine Woods.
