

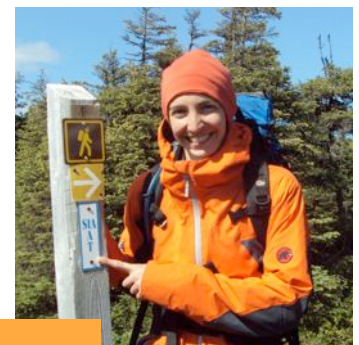
AMC Historical Film Fest 1940's Recreation in Maine
