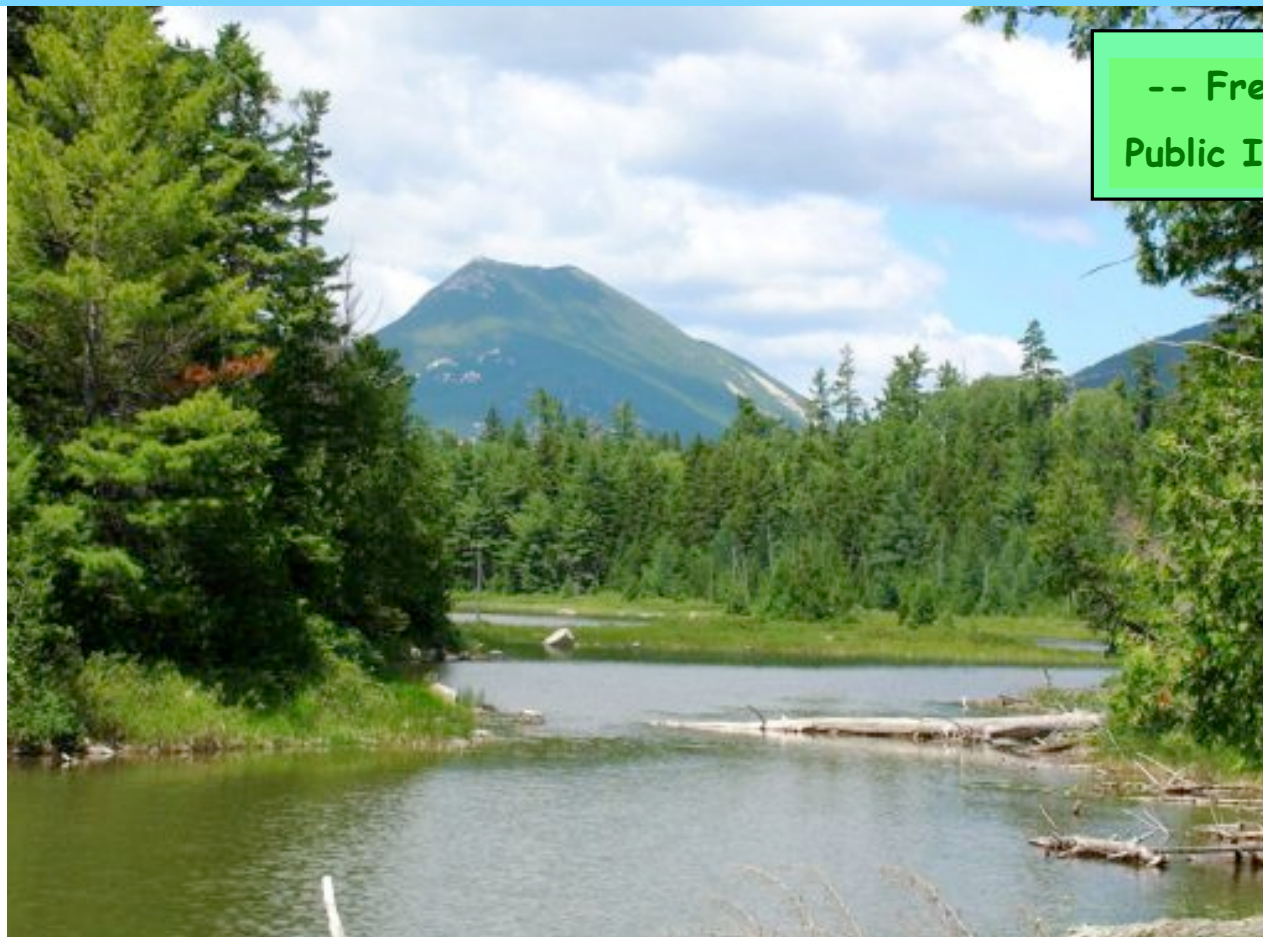


Hiking Baxter State Park End-to-End with Carey & Fran



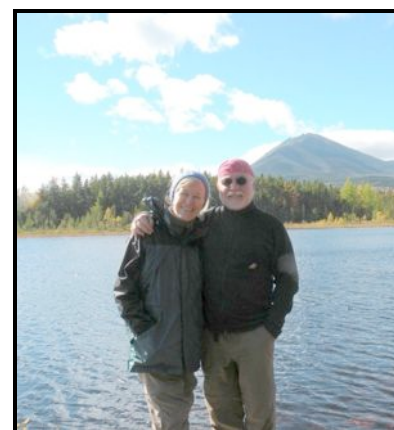

The route covered 85 miles from Togue Pond Gate at the southern end of Baxter State Park to Matagamon Gate in the far northeast corner. Enjoying this long-term dream of a winding and scenic wilderness thru-hike, they combined at least a dozen trails and took in every fabulous vista. Four food drops stashed along the way and nights spent in lean-tos and one cabin meant reasonably light packs.
