



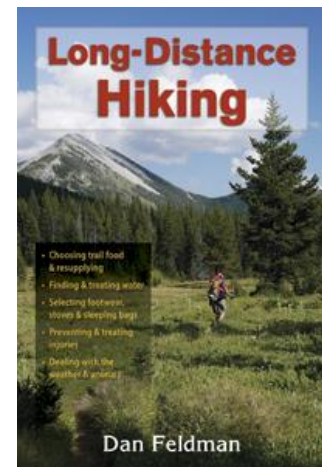
The Appalachian Mountain Club – Maine Chapter presents
