Local authors team up to tell their story through photographs...



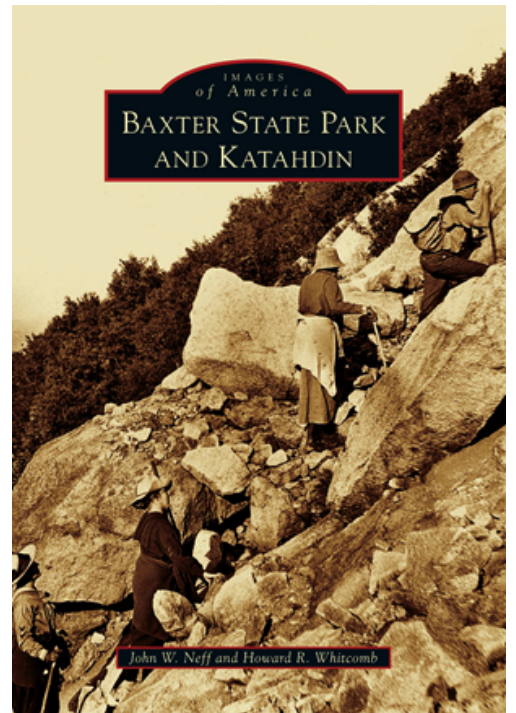
