

Maine Wilderness Lodges: Paradise in the North Woods



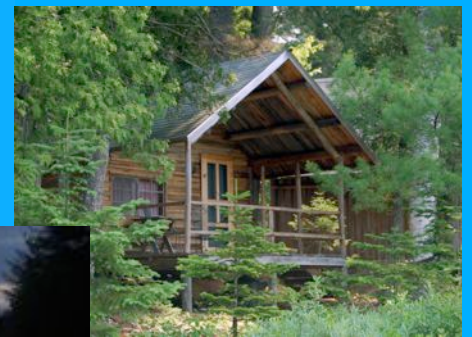

These new log main lodges have refurbished trapper cabins, new central bathhouses, and wood-fired saunas.
