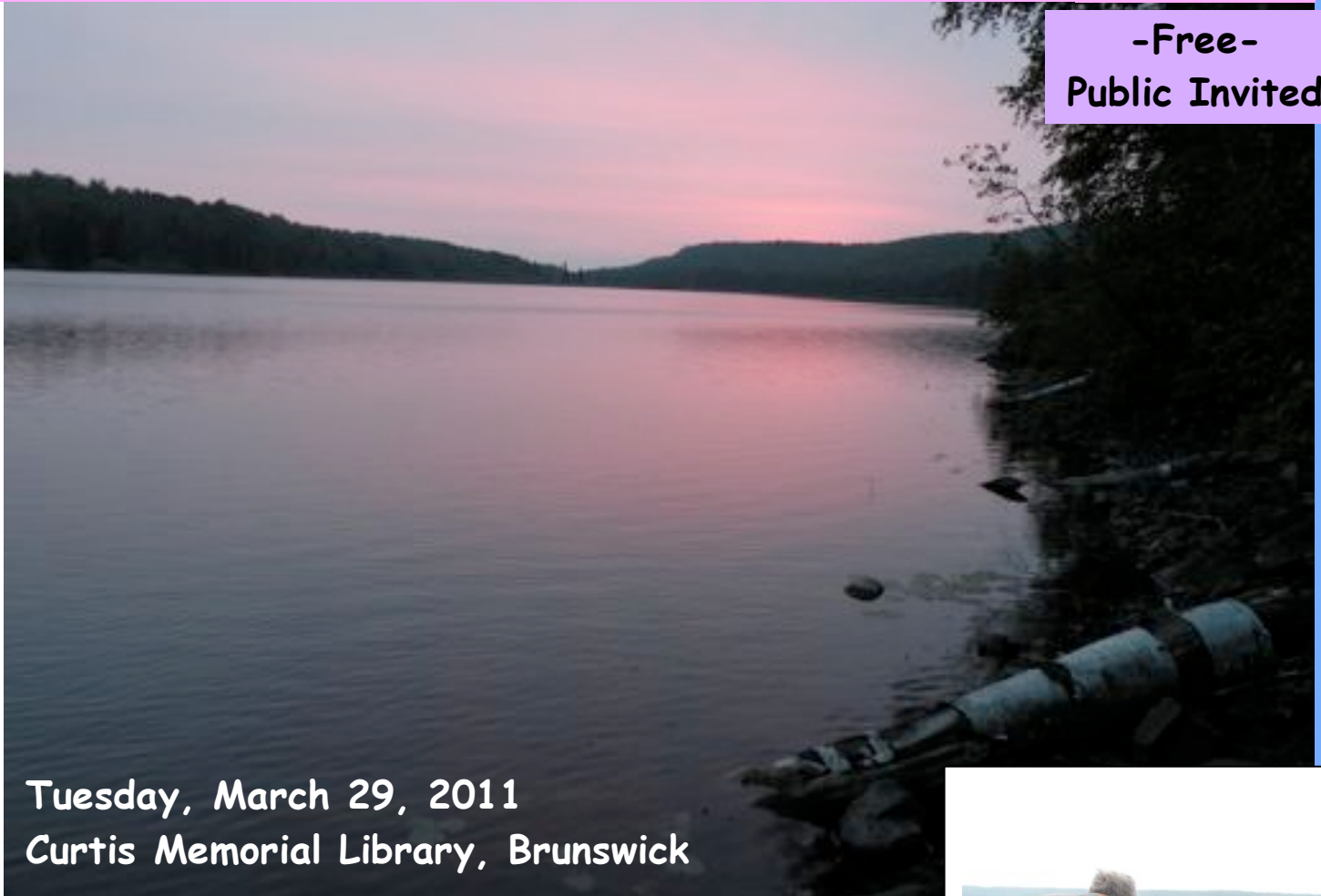


Backpacking in the Middle of Lake Superior: Experiencing Isle Royale National Park

He tackled a 42-mile wilderness footpath traversing the length of the island finding ridgetop views, gorgeous lakes, great campsites, and delicious thimbleberries.
