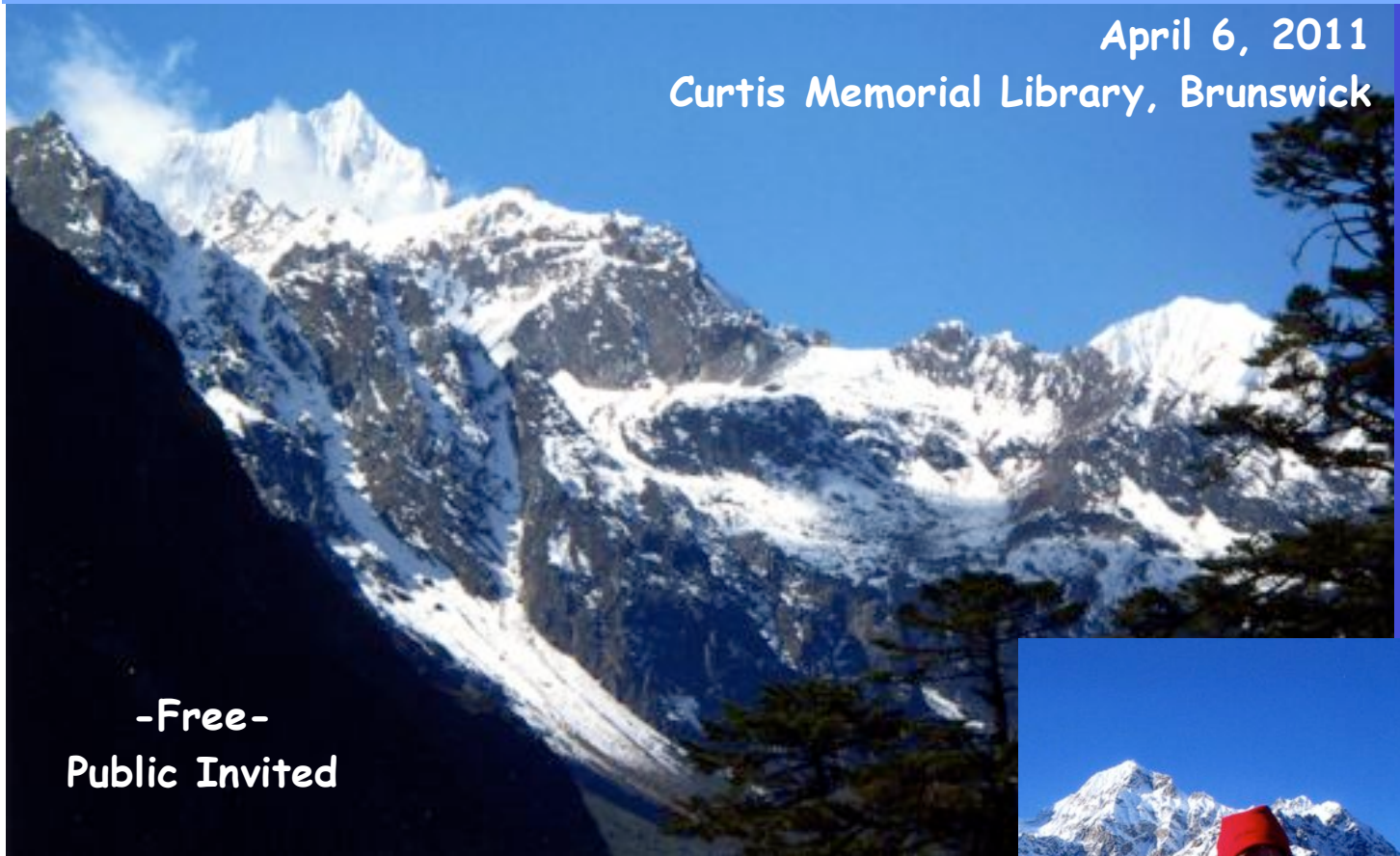


To Mt. Kanchenjunga in the Himalayas: Trekking with Jamling Tenzing Norgay

Madelyn Given was invited by Jamling Tenzing Norgay to the remote east base camp of India's Kanchenjunga, the third highest mountain in the world. Given had already thru-hiked the AT for the first time after retiring as an elementary school teacher, then ran a marathon and climbed a high-altitude mountain on each of the seven continents. On Wednesday, April 6th, Given will talk about trekking to Kanchenjunga with Jamling, camping on the Zemu Glacier, visiting monasteries, and eating in the homes of the Lepcha people along the way.
