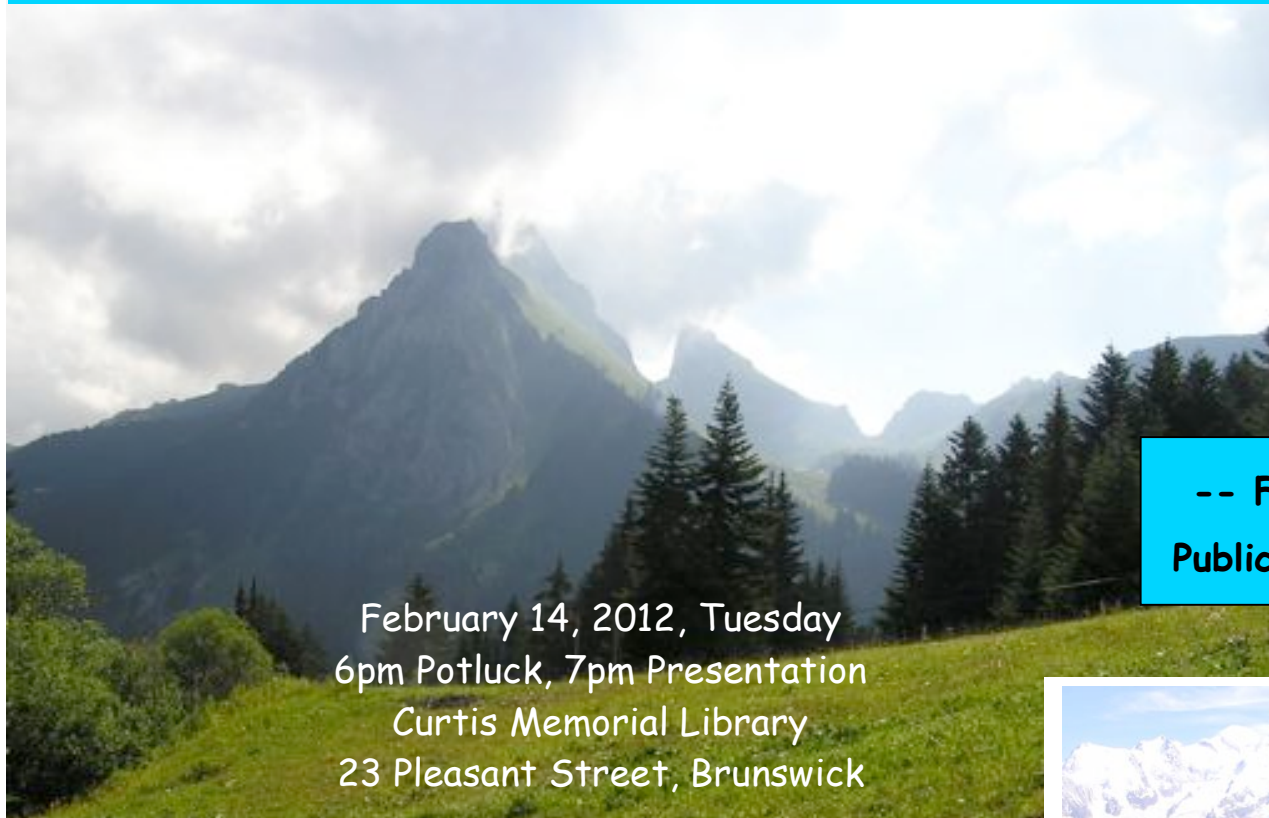


Spectacular French Alpine Hiking on the GR5

Tulle Frazer and Rob Bryan will present stunning slides and personal stories of a recent hut-to-hut hike on the GR5 route in the French Alps. While hiking through a variety of ecosystems from pastures to woods to sub-alpine meadows to glaciers, they also experienced equally stunning distant views of magnificent mountains, some snow-covered, some not. In the valleys they visited wonderfully iconic villages sampling the varied regional cuisine, and while on mountain paths they were often remote from the effects of civilization.
